✓ Mission (common aims):

✓ **Meeting and work division**

For our partnership We consider that it is important to organize meetings frequently.

- Preliminary meeting before projects – in the hosting country of the project – where specific roles will be attributed.

✓ **Monitoring**

We think that it is important to create monitoring committee composed by 11 components (one from each organization). Each organization can choose its member of the monitoring committee.

✓ **Balance/evaluation**

In order to evaluate the work of the partnership are foreseen two questionnaires for year to know the number of submitted projects, the number of projects approved and the number of organization involved (in the periods of reference).
